SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF CITY OF CAPE TOWN SPORTS FACILITIES UNDER ALERT LEVEL 3

DATE: 30 DECEMBER 2020

The National State of Disaster declared in terms of the Disaster Management Act, 57 of 2002 ("the Act") has been extended by the State President due to the adverse impact of the COVID 19 pandemic on our Country.

As from Tuesday, 29 December 2020, the country has moved to Lockdown Alert Level 3 and the Cape Town City Metro has officially been declared as a hotspot area.

In lieu of this declaration and the Regulations gazetted on 29 December 2020, The Recreation and Parks Department ("The Department") has closed all of the City's sports facilities for the purpose of both training and competition until Friday the 15th of January 2021.

During this 2-week period, facilities will only be available for professional / elite sport training and competition and only on request from the relevant federation.

Further communication will be provided once we have received further guidance and directions from the National Minister of Sport, Arts and Culture.
